Command and Control Cybersecurity Threat Exercises for the Energy Sector

The Norwich University Applied Research Institutes (NUARI) has been conducting command and control exercises using the DECIDE platform since the late 2000's. The DECIDE exercises simulate cyber-attacks for organizations and their partners to stress and test incident response plans, resulting in after action reports to improve strategic communications, compliance, business risk, and overall resilience to cyber-attacks. NUARI has executed DECIDE exercises with organizations of all sizes, from thousands of participants spread across hundreds of international locations, to fewer than 30 participants in a local initiative.
